

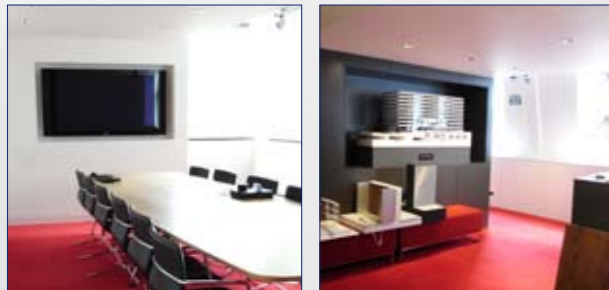

Overview: Refurbishment Works & Moves and Changes Programme

A fast-track refurbishment programme precisely executed enabled the successful relocation of South Eastern Rail from Cannon Street to London Wall.

The £70,000 project took just three weeks to complete. First, we undertook a full property survey and agreed on the specification of works. We then obtained approval from the landlord and secured Listed Building consent.

During the fit-out, we managed the installations and alterations of ceilings, lighting, electrical and mechanical services, creating new partition walling, a dedicated communications room and a kitchenette facility. We also managed all the decoration work, including the fitting of new carpets to a very high standard.

Pellings Reception

Overview: Rebranding Programme

The new Reception Area at Pelling's Offices in Bromley was the finishing touch to the rebranding of the company and marked the changeover to LLP.

The design concept was to create a sense of interest and variety in a very ordinary, square reception area. The use of strong asymmetric geometry created a dynamic main entrance to the offices, reflecting Pelling's future corporate approach. A cleverly integrated hidden sliding wall formed part of the design, to allow discreet access to the services panel area.

The use of new branded colours in the contemporary seating and Armourcolour Polished Plaster Feature Walls complemented the new layout. Frosted manifestation on the façade windows helped to create a more inviting reception area, without reducing the light or visual connection with the High Street.
